Game Summary – First Impressions

Clash Royale is a game that combines elements of collectible card games, online multiplayer, and tower defense. It is a fun and engaging game developed by Supercell, who developed the famous Clash of Clans game. Unlike Clash of Clans though this is a real-time strategy game. Instead of having to wait until you are attacked you have paired up with a player right away and go head to head in a battle to the finish.

The goal of the game is to destroy the opposite player's towers. Whoever destroys more towers at the end of the game wins. A deck of eight cards is assembled before every match, and the card is dealt randomly from the prearranged deck.

There are thirteen arenas that are accessed based on how many trophies a player has been able to collect. One of the arenas is special and changes every season. t

Gameplay

The gameplay is a strategy based where players will play cards that contain, buildings, spells, armies, and other powerups. Cards are earned over time, and part of the fun is arranging the best card deck to have a good mix of defensive and offensive abilities. There are different tiers of cards too, so assembling the best cards to make up your decks will take time.

Using cards cost elixir, and every player will start the game with 5 elixir points. Elixir points get replenished every 2.8 seconds, with a maximum of 10 elixir points per game. Players must spend their elixir points and cards strategically so that they can have the best chance of maximizing their victory.

As you win matches you will earn trophies, and those trophies will give you access to better arenas. Also, you will be grouped with players with a similar amount of trophies, so you will be on relatively equal footing with your opponents. ### Final Thoughts

This is a great strategy game, and if you enjoy card games and battle games then you will enjoy this game immensely. It can be hard at first to collect cards, but once you begin to collect cards it will be more enjoyable to set up your deck and fight your battles.

The tutorial rounds are extremely well done, and they will have you feeling like a pro in no time. The only downside is that after a while matches do get redundant, and more cards and options are needed to make the game a bit more interesting.
