The Microsoft OneDrive app is Microsoft's cloud storage service. Microsoft OneDrive gives you a cloud storage platform for your files, photos, documents, videos, and many more. Like its competitors like Dropbox, Microsoft OneDrive gives you a backup to your data in case of erasure or device failure. The Microsoft OneDrive also integrates with Windows 8 and 10. You can easily view the files that you had previously uploaded via the computer.

New signup into the OneDrive cloud service offers 5GB free storage. To back up files onto the Microsoft OneDrive app, select your desired files and click on Upload. The photos or videos will initiate the upload process. A spectacular feature of the Microsoft OneDrive is the Camera roll. The camera roll automatically syncs any videos and photos you capture.

The Microsoft OneDrive incorporates a personal vault for data security. To access files within the vault, you need identity verification, such as fingerprint or passcode. The Microsoft OneDrive also integrates with the Microsoft Office apps on your iPhone or iPad. You seamlessly open your documents in real-time with either Word, Excel, or OneNote.

In addition to the vault encryption, you can also set up passwords on your share links. When sharing your files, you can also set up a time-lapsed link. Upgrading to the Microsoft 365 service earns you 1TB of OneDrive storage space.

A downside of the Microsoft OneDrive is its incompatibility with editing. You cannot edit documents with the OneDrive app. You will have to install third-party applications. However, if you have the Microsoft Office app on your iPhone or iPad, you can edit your documents.
